What do you like about Option 1?	Most direct route to Boral Quarry reduces which reduces haulage costs, greenhouse gas emissions and impacts on residents. It utilises traffic lights which are more efficient for traffic movement than roundabouts associated with Option 2.
Is there anything that concerns you about Option 1?	No - we support the Option 1.
What do you like about Option 2?	We prefer Option 1 for reasons below.
Is there anything that concerns you about Option 2?	Longer haul route from the Boral quarry compared with Option 1. Also we have concerns that the roundabout at the intersection with Dayboro Road will exceed capacity. We are also concerned about introducing new traffic impacts on those residents which back onto the road.
