- Australian Hardwoods can easily be finished with a clear decking oil or stain. Alternatively, the timber can be left to weather. After timber has weathered it can be restored to its original colour by resanding and coating.
- Boral Timber white mahogany decking is Responsible Wood Chain of Custody certified providing peace of mind that Boral's Decking is sourced from sustainably managed and legal forestry.
